Nehemiah 1:8: Leviticus 26:33 'You, however, I will scatter among the nations and will draw out a sword after you, as your land becomes desolate and your cities become waste.

God's promise of restoration (vv. 8-10)

Nehemiah 1:9: Deuteronomy 30:2,4 <sup>2</sup>and you return to the LORD your God and obey Him with all your heart and soul according to all that I command you today, you and your sons.... <sup>4</sup>“If your outcasts are at the ends of the earth, from there the LORD your God will gather you, and from there He will bring you back.

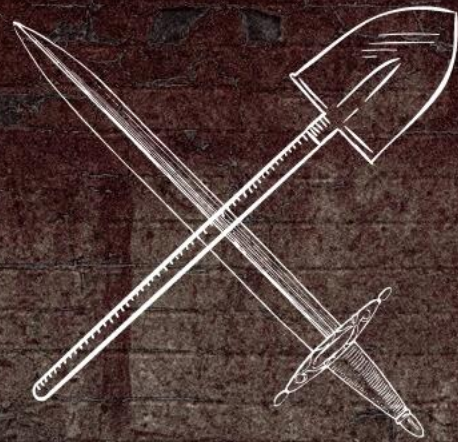
