## COVID-19 Protocol for Volunteers and Workers

I am experiencing Covid-like symptoms. What should I do?

- 1. Take your temperature.
- 2. Have you been exposed to anyone with active Covid?
- 3. What are your specific symptoms?
- 4. With this information, contact your area ministry leader (see below) to let them know or call the church office.
  - a. You can get a rapid Covid test. If the result is negative, you are good to come to church.
  - b. You can get a free, 3 day test from the health department.
- 5. If the test result is negative, you can come back to church. If it is positive, you should stay in quarantine for 10 days since the symptoms first appeared and 24 hours with no fever.

Someone in my house is experiencing Covid-like symptoms. What should I do?

- 1. Contact your director to let them know or call the church office.
- 2. Monitor your own symptoms. Wash hands frequently and wear a mask.
- 3. The person who is sick should seek out a Covid test. If the test is positive, you and everyone in your household should guarantine.
- 4. If the family member has Covid, the quarantine period for you is 14 days from the date the person receives word they are Covid free, unless you also receive a negative test result in the time period after they stop showing symptoms.

I was in the same room with someone who is experiencing symptoms of Covid.

- 1. Contact your director to let them know or call the church office.
- 2. Monitor your own symptoms. Wash your hands frequently.
- 3. Keep checking with the person to find out if their test is positive or negative.
  - a. If positive, you may need to test and quarantine.
  - b. If negative, you are fine to return to church.

My spouse or child was in the same room as someone who has Covid. What should I do?

- 1. You should be fine as long as they were not within six feet for a period of 15 minutes or more.
- 2. They should carefully monitor their symptoms, and if they begin to exhibit symptoms, you should follow the guidelines listed above. However, as long as there are no symptoms, it is highly unlikely that you would catch the virus secondhand.
