## **TUITION CONTRACT**

I understand that I am making a commitment to pay the entire semester's tuition of \$195.00 per semester with a minimum of 12 lessons or classes. Withdrawing from a class does not release me from my contract to pay the tuition in full.

I realize tuition may be paid in full or in monthly payments. If I choose to make a full semester payment prior to September 14, I will pay \$190.

After or on September 14, the full payment will be \$195.00. If I choose the payment plan, I will make a payment of \$65.00 at the first lesson in September and submit payments of \$65.00 by the first lessons October, and November.

I understand that payments received after the 1st of the month will incur a \$10.00 late fee.

I will give the payments to the Academy Director, leave them in the tan box on the wall outside the Church Administrator's office in an envelope marked "Music Academy," or give them to a ministry assistant during regular church office hours.

I will not put lesson payments in the church offering. I understand that those monies go to the general church treasury and do not count toward Academy payments.

If I enroll in the Academy after September 14, tuition will be pro-rated, and the first monthly payment will be due at the time of registration. I agree to pay be a \$20.00 charge for all returned checks. I further understand that all music and additional materials needed by the student are not included in the tuition and will be purchased separately at the direction of the instructor.
