Reopening of Second Baptist Church instructions

- We will reopen on Sunday May 17 for WORSHIP ONLY.
- There will ONLY be 2 Worship services. First will be at 9:00 AM, the last will be at 11:00AM.
- <u>IMPORTANT</u>: Doors will open at 8:30 & 10:30 to reduce any cross contamination and still allow time for everyone to be seated.
- Both services will be live with Pastor Brian. There will be 2 separate locations for the services and ONLY 2 doors will be open for entrance.
- The first 150 will park in the upper parking lot, enter the <u>MAIN FRONT</u> entrance and be escorted or directed to socially distance seating in the sanctuary. The remaining folks will be directed to the rear parking lot enter the FMC entrance and be escorted or directed to socially distance seating in the FMC. <u>ALL OTHER ENTRANCES WILL REMAINED CLOSED.</u>
- THE KING CIRCLE UPPER PARKING LOT WILL BE CLOSED.
- There WILL BE **<u>NO CHILDCARE</u>**. Children are to remain with parents or guardians at all times.
- For the safety of everyone LIMITED MOVEMENT is suggested and appreciated.
- Once you have been seated please remain in your seats until the service is over. If you need to leave the worship center at any time after you have been seated, the welcome team will try to accommodate you in another area of the Worship Center. Out of an abundance of caution and care for those around you, you will not be able to return to the seats you were in.

- Sanctuary- The services will be dismissed by rows to allow social distancing while exiting out the LEFT-HAND side of the sanctuary ONLY. Those leaving out by the door closest to the sound booth will use the side door between the restrooms and the welcome center while those leaving out by the lower door will exit out the double doors directly across from them. We ask that you maintain social distancing.
- There WILL BE NO OFFERING taken during the service. There will be a white offering box on a table each exit for you to drop your tithes in if you choose to do so.
- There will be face masks available but not required and plenty of hand sanitizer for your use. Someone will be cleaning the seats and bathrooms between services so the number of persons in the rest rooms will be limited as well.
- We ask that you remain on the floor that you enter on for the length of your visit.
- Please be assured that all of these decisions were made strictly for the safety of the SBC family. We thank you in advance for your patience while we continue to see this though.
